Carriage Replacement

For ProCut Servo and Contour series Vinyl Cutters



1-1 Remove End Caps

- Make sure the cutter is off.
- Remove the four screws from left and right end cap.
- Two are on the back side in the same place.





1-2 Remove Top of Cutter

There are 2 screws that hold the top on, you will need to remove these fasteners. Be careful not to pinch the cables between the end plate and the top cover. We recommend placing something here to prevent the top cover from pinching wires while performing carriage changes.




PINCH POINT

1-3 Loosen Cable



 Loosen this screw to loosen the cable that guides the carriage.

1-4 Unscrew the Chip



 Unscrew the carriage position sensor board from the Carriage. It is very **important** you do this so the sensors on the bottom of the board do not get damaged. Be careful to contain the nuts on the underside of the sensor board as they are small and can get lost easily.

1-5 Remove Carriage

- Loosen the screw on the right of the carriage cover.
- Push down on the carriage to release the bottom wheels and lift off the carriage.





1-6 Remove Chip

- Unscrew the 4 wires from the board.
- You may want to mark which order these go in.





1-7 Remove Carriage



Loosen the screws on the back of the carriage to remove the cable.

Repeat in reverse to install new carriage -The End-
